Auxiliaries who won Program Awards at the Department Convention, I would like to extend my congratulations for your support of the programs and for doing such a great job!

Update on Annual Dues – At the Department Convention on June 7, 2024, the recommendation was approved by the delegates in attendance to raise the Annual dues sent to the Department Treasurer from \$7.00 to \$10.00 (a \$3.00 increase) effective **July 1, 2024**.

Auxiliary Treasurers, as of 7/01/24, the per capita amount for annual members' dues that need to be either mailed to the Department Treasurer or paid through MALTA is **\$20.00** per annual member. If a check is sent for the previous amount of \$12.00, the check will be returned for the correct amount.

- 2. Auxiliary Bonds are due to be paid prior to **August 31, 2024**. The Auxiliary Bond may be paid through MALTA. Treasurers please make a copy of your Bond once it has been paid. Per the Bylaws, the Bond is to be held by the President and a copy in the Secretary's and Treasurer's books. If your Auxiliary needs assistance in processing the Bond through MALTA, please contact District President, Tina Roberts.

- 2. **Auxiliary Presidents** Reminder Provide a copy of your Auxiliary's last quarterly audit and membership status (as of June 30, 2024) needs to be given to the Post Commander within 30 days following assuming the position as President.
- 3. **Newly Elected Auxiliary Treasurers** All newly elected Auxiliary Treasurers are required to complete IRS form 8822B Change of Address or Responsible Party Business. If your Auxiliary Treasurer needs a copy of this form, please contact District Secretary Karen Dotson.
- 4. **990N** Acceptance or Rejection file A request has been made for each Auxiliary provide a copy of their 990N Acceptance or Rejection once the 990N has been completed. The copy is to be attached to the Official Visit form at the time the District Representative completes the Official Visit. I highly encourage all auxiliaries to process their 990N IRS form prior to the Official Visit. You can start to process your 990N on July 15, 2024.
- 5. **2nd Quarter Audit** The April, May, June Quarterly Audit is due to the Department Treasurer by **August 31, 2024** or sooner. Audits may be sent through the USPS mail, scanned via email or faxed to the Dept. Treasurer. Please do not **TEXT** the Audit.
- 6. **Department Auxiliary News** Auxiliary members who wish to order a subscription for the Department Auxiliary News will find an order form attached to share with your members. Details for ordering may be found on the order form.
- 7. **Department Program Guide Books** Auxiliary members who wish to purchase a 2024-2025 Program Guide Book, please contact Department Secretary, Chris Leavor at (716) 676-2400 or email CAL2027@hotmail.com. The cost of the Program Guide Book is \$7.00. I encourage Auxiliaries to purchase several copies of the Program Guidebook to share with your active members to review the programs and assist in reporting your Auxiliary activities.
- 8. **Official Visit Form** The form has been condensed to 1 page instead of 2 to remove the repetitive questions. Please note, the District Representative executing the Official Visit will be requesting to see the last 4 completed audits by the Auxiliary to be reported on the form.
