A Mentoring Moment - Sec. 211 - Standing Rules - General Reminders

Sec. 211 - Standing Rules (Auxiliaries, Districts and Departments)

A. Auxiliaries, Districts and Departments may establish Standing Rules to provide for specified operations, activities, events, expenses and disbursements between meetings provided such rules do not conflict with the National or Department Bylaws.

B. Custom has the status of a Standing Rule. Standing Rules may be amended, modified, or rescinded at any meeting.

- 1. If prior notice is given, the vote is by majority vote of those members present.
- 2. If previous notice is not given, the vote is by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of those members present. **Standing Rules become effective immediately.**
- C. A copy of the current Standing Rules must be included in the Secretary Book, and any time they are changed, rescinded or amended.

\*\*\* Note...It is suggested that the Auxiliary President, Secretary, and Treasurer have a copy of the most current Auxiliary Standing Rules. The Trustees should have a copy of the current Auxiliary Standing Rules when they are doing the Auxiliary Quarterly Audit.

### **Examples of a Good Standing Rule:**

The Auxiliary Treasurer may purchase the **Auxiliary Bond** by July 31<sup>st</sup>. The payment may be processed through MALTA between July 15<sup>th</sup> and July 31<sup>st</sup> of the current year. (If the Treasurer does not have computer access, an Auxiliary check may be submitted to National Headquarters. An Auxiliary check requires the signatures of the Treasurer and President.)

The Auxiliary Treasurer may submit .25 cents per member to the **VFW National Home Health & Happiness** fund. Total donation will be based on the Auxiliary's membership as of June 30<sup>th</sup>. The payment may be processed through MALTA for the current year. (If the Treasurer does not have computer access, an Auxiliary check may be submitted to National Headquarters. An Auxiliary check requires the signatures of the Treasurer and President.)

A memorial donation of \$25 (or amount decided upon) shall be sent to the VFW National Home when a member passes away. If another specific charity has been requested by the family, the memorial donation will be sent to that charity.

### **Scholarship Program**

Scholarship Chairman, Charlene Carnright wants to remind Auxiliaries they should be contacting Schools, Youth Groups, and connecting on Social Media communicating the VFW Auxiliary Art Contests. The Illustrating America Art Contest, which is part of the Youth Activities Program, is open for students in grades K-8. The 3-D Patriotic Art Contest and the Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest is open to students in grades 9-12. Applications can be printed from MALTA under Member Resources then scroll down to Scholarship. Due date for art submissions is **March 31**st.
