- 1. **990N Acceptance or Rejection Receipt DUE DATE: November 15, 2024**. A request has been made for each Auxiliary to provide a copy of their 990N Acceptance or Rejection receipt once the 990N has been completed. The copy is to be attached to the Official Visit form at the time the District Representative completes the Official Visit. I highly encourage all auxiliaries to process their 990N EZ IRS form prior to the date of their scheduled Official Visit.
- 2. **3rd Quarter Audit** The July, August, September Quarterly Audit is due to the Department Treasurer by **November 30, 2024** or sooner. Audits may be sent through the USPS mail, scanned via email or faxed to the Dept. Treasurer. Please do not **TEXT** the Audit.
- 3. **Donation Report** form which can be found on page 5 in the Department Program Guidebook may still be sent to the Department Treasurer with your donations to the programs. District Q's and A's Section

Question 1 Answer 1

Why do Trustees need to do the audit? Why can't the Treasurer do it? In accordance of Bylaw Sec. 814 – Trustees, Duties (All Levels)

- 1. All audits are to be completed by the Trustees.
- 2. The President, Secretary and Treasurer should attend the audit. They are not allowed to perform the audit.
- 3. It shall be the duty of the Trustees to properly audit the books and records of the Auxiliary Treasurer and Secretary no later than the end of the month following the expiration of each quarterly period.
- 4. The Trustees shall verify all expenditures of the Auxiliary and certify by their signatures to the correctness of each bill before payment may be made of same by the Treasurer

Question 2

Why can't someone join under an Aunt, Uncle, or Cousin?

Answer 2

In accordance with Bylaw Sec. 101 – Eligibility - Membership in the VFW Auxiliary is limited to Husbands/Wives, Father/Mother, Grandfathers/Grandmothers, Sons/Daughters, Brothers/Sisters, Grandsons/Granddaughters, Widows/Widowers of persons who were or are eligible for membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. Additionally, a Resolution was placed on the floor at the National Convention 2024, Louisville, KY to expand eligibility and it was Not Adopted.

Question 3 Answer 3

Why does the Treasurer need to read the whole Treasurers Report and just not the totals? In accordance with Bylaw Sec. 813A – Auxiliary Treasurer - Bullet #14 a,b and Bullet #15- The Treasurer's report shall be presented in any manner determined by vote of the Auxiliary. a. Shall include in detail, all receipts and disbursements of the last meeting. b. And pre-approved customary expenses and all receipts since the last meeting. 15. No motion to accept this report is necessary.

Question 4

What is the process for transferring membership from one Auxiliary to another? Is a DD-214 required? Does the member need to fill out an application? Is there a fee sent to the Department Treasurer.

Answer 4

Review Bylaw Sec 106, 106A and 106B for complete details. (See pages 17 and 18)

A DD-214 is not required as applicants who wish to transfer between Auxiliaries need not show proof of eligibility but must provide their current membership card as proof for eligibility has been established and approved with their current Auxiliary or as a Member At Large. (See Bylaw Sec. 106)

Yes an application is required to be completed by the Annual Member or the Life Member to transfer to another Auxiliary. (See Sec. 106A sub-bullet #1 and Sec. 106B sub-bullet #1)

There is no fee to be sent to the Department Treasurer if there is a Life Member Transfer. The Application must be sent to the Department Treasurer in order to process the Auxiliary transfer and request the new Life Membership card from National. (See Sec. 106B, sub-bullet B2)

If the applicant is a Non-Paying Annual Transfer, the accepting Auxiliary will NOT be liable for any dues on the transferring member. (See Sec. 106A, sub-bullet #E 2)

If the applicant is a Paying Annual Transfer, the accepting Auxiliary will be liable to pay the Department and National dues for the Auxiliary member. (See Sec. 106A, sub-bullet #F2)
