

- A template for creating your own local fact sheet.
- · Proven methods of generating publicity.

Press/media releases are a great way to get the word out about Auxiliary functions and what we are all about. Less is more! A few helpful hints include:

- ✓ Your release should not exceed one page; and never be more than one and half pages! The reason for this is reporters scan most press releases.
- ✓ Make sure you include all the important who's, what's, where's, when's and why's. Carefully proofread; use spell check; and then ask a friend to look!
- ✓ Always provide relevant links to your website or Facebook page, a copy of the National Fact Sheet and the National Elevator Speech where writers can learn more about your mission and what you have accomplished.
- ✓ Is this a story and a photo opportunity? If so, include a line at the top: Photo opportunity: then explain it!

It is an honor to serve as Department Historian /Media Relations Chairman this year and will do so with much excitement! "Light the Flame of Hope for Our Veterans" will provide us with wonderful memories while "Banding Together for Our Veterans."

Welcome to all the new officers who will be elected or re-elected this month. All Auxiliary Presidents or Secretaries should have received the election packet in their emails. Please look the forms over. There will be a Department ZOOM the first Wednesday of April at 7:30 PM where you will be able to ask any questions you have. Every District President receives the invitation. If your Auxiliary doesn't get it - ask your District President for the link. In addition, the link will be posted on the Department website, www.vfwauxny.org, under the Resources tab, click on the 'Did You Know' page. Some Auxiliaries make a small "party" out of the ZOOMs by getting together and attending together.

It is important to send election forms and delegates IMMEDIATELY after your elections, and then the properly signed installation form IMMEDIATELY after installation of officers. It seems like every year we are still trying to get the information in JUNE or JULY. April for elections- send- May for installations- send- All Done-Thanks.

When electing delegates, remember most Districts have 4 meetings a year and it is mandatory that someone from each Auxiliary be there. It does not always have to be the President and it does not always have to be the same person. Try to choose three or four people who at the very least can give up one meeting day a year. I always encourage as many members as possible attend as many meetings as possible because Districts are schools of instruction, and you get a direct line to what National and Department are asking the Auxiliaries to do. But, in all honesty to give ONE day a year to attend a meeting seems like so little to ask, given the sacrifices the veteran whose service one joined to honor made for us.

I remind any Auxiliary that has members who have been members for 45 or more years to send the recognition forms that were distributed in the Spring Conference packs to the Chairman, Deborah Fucina. The deadline might be in May, and it's easy to set it aside and forget, but there are literally hundreds of members deserving of recognition, and she cannot do all of them in a day or two. It is very helpful if you do them as soon as possible to give her time to do her job along the way.

Those experiences never dissipate and have resulted in a number of mental health issues including Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) and its associated symptoms of feelings or dreams, disturbing thoughts, sleeplessness, an increase in fight-or-flight response, and puts a person at a higher risk of suicide and intentional self-harm.



Each of us has a role in promoting mental health awareness. We need to take care of ourselves first to be able to take care of others. Practice mindfulness. <u>Mindfulness</u> is a type of mediation in which you focus on being intensely aware of what you are sensing and feeling in the moment, without interpretation or judgment. It involves breathing methods, guided imagery, and other practices to relax the body and mind and help reduce stress. Your VA Hospital and their Suicide Awareness Coalition can help you plan your own program of mental health awareness activities. After you take care of yourself you will be able to take care of others and then recognize the need to help care for our veterans and their families. If you suspect anyone to be in crisis, call the *crisis line at 988, press 1!*
