#### Congratulations to all the Auxiliaries that received awards at the Department Convention!

I know! I know! None of us does what we do for an award or certificate, but one still cannot deny it <u>does</u> feel good to receive some recognition for a year's worth of work. The Department of NY ROCKS! I cannot wait to see what happens at National.

By now, I should have ALL Election and Installation reports.

- ♦ No EIN # was probably the most missing piece of information on the Election form.
- ♦ Deadlines, again, were an issue. Too often we wait until the last minute ("I work best under pressure") and then something happens, and we can't get it done. "Immediately, but no later than May 1" doesn't mean you have until May 1<sup>st</sup>. It means if your Auxiliary meets the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of the month, I should have your election report and delegates by that Friday if sent by email, and definitely in the mail and on its way if using USPS. If your Auxiliary meets the last week of the month the pressure is on to get it to me by May 1st.
- Not submitting the election report "because I entered it in MALTA already." I very much appreciate when an Auxiliary does the MALTA entry, but I still need the report for my job.
- Not completing the contact information. I was looking up information and completing YOUR reports. Maybe ask the elected officers to fill in their own information on election night? They need to be present to be elected in most cases, so have them fill in their information on the election form before they leave the meeting room.

Now, as we move into the next Membership year, let's focus on meeting deadlines. For example, Auxiliaries need to bond the offices of President and Treasurer for double the amount of funds you have. Just because you won't be suspended until August 31st, doesn't mean you should wait until August 30th to get it done. Let's aim to meet the July 31st deadline to help the Department earn points for the Circle of Excellence and ensure that NY Auxiliaries are always in GOOD STANDING.

Or paying dues. June 30<sup>th</sup> is NOT the deadline. Members do NOT have until June to pay their dues. **An unpaid annual Member is not a member after December 31<sup>st</sup>**. They have no rights or benefits after that date- until they pay their dues. They have until June to <u>regain</u> their privileges of membership and be reinstated to "continuous" membership without having to reapply.

Let's aim to get business done before deadlines this new year. I'm making that my Resolution, how about you?

### A note from Official Visit Coordinator ~ PDP Sandra Flynn ~


Brothers and Sisters,
