- **Gold Star-** is a banner displayed when a family member has made the ulOmate sacrifice while serving in the armed forces during war zone.
- Blue Star- is a banner displayed when a family member is actively serving in the armed forces.
- Silver Star- is a banner displayed when a family member has been wounded, contracted a serious illness or injury in a war zone.
- White Star- the White Star designation recognizes families who have lost a service member to suicide, whether they were military or first responders.
