The Hospital Program is one of the first nationally adopted programs for the organization

- The First National Program Chairman was appointed in 1928.
- Hospital volunteerism of VFW Auxiliary member predates the formation of the Auxiliary in 1914.
- Documented involvement dates back as far as 1899, when precursors of the organization were active.





How can you contribute and participate in the Hospital Program?

- Volunteering at any VA or Non-Facility or clinics such as local hospitals, Veteran's homes, and nursing homes.
- Volunteers can be members, non-members, youth and family.
- Opportunities are based on the facility. Some have volunteer programs with specific duties or activities.

Currently, there are 1.9 million living women Veterans, who make up 9.4 percent of the total Veteran population. At each VA medical center nationwide, a women Veterans program manager is designated to advise and advocate for women Veterans. These program managers help coordinate services for eligible women for both primary and specialized care.





- Services offered for Women Veterans are:
- Sex-specific primary care programs.
- Mental health programs geared specifically for women.
- Special services are available to women who have experienced military sexual trauma (MST).
- Manages and screens for chronic conditions.
- Reproductive health care.
- Special programs providing services for homeless women Veterans and victims of domestic violence.
