Voice of Democracy - Due Date — 10/31/24 due to Post Theme is: "Is America Today, Our Forefathers Vision?"

- Audio Essay Contest 3 to 5 minutes
- Open to all students Grades 9 to 12 who attend public, private and home schooled students.
- Students must be a resident of the state where their essay is entered.
- One Department winner will be forwarded on to VFW National Headquarters.



### <u>Scholarships</u>

Patriot's Pen - Due Date - 10/31/24 due to Post Theme: "My Voice in America's Democracy?"

- 300 to 400 word written essay contest
- Open to all students enrolled in Grades 6 to 8, who attend public, private and homes schooled students.
- Students must be a resident of the state where their essay is entered.
- One Department winner will be forwarded to VFW National Headquarters.



#### <u>Scholarships</u>

#### Continuing Education Scholarship - Due Date - 2/15/25

- Open to any VFW Auxiliary member who has been a member for at least a year, their spouse, son, or daughter with a financial need.
- Entrants must be 21 years old by February 15, 2025.
- The Continuing Education Scholarship is \$1,250 and is awarded to one winner in each
  of the four Conferences.
- Applications must be received at Auxiliary National Headquarters by February 15, 2025.
